	<p>First letter of his daughter’s name.</p>		<p>There are actually 17 of these here but you only need <u>one</u>.</p>
	<p>The first letter of what Devon’s Saint is doing here.</p>		<p>In memory of ...the initial of his position (it appears twice).</p>
	<p>All alone on the side of this.</p>	<p>You should now have nine letters (two of which are the same). Rearrange them to spell an important word in the early church.</p>
